Introduction/Tutorial screen

Tapped check it out without swiping
Thought tapping check it out would bring him to the next slide
Understood the feature from the first 3 slides
Clicks check it out without swiping
Understood feature
Doesn't like idea of skipping small talk
Click check it out before swiping
Understood that feature is more of a date planner, align schedules
Clicks check it out
Would rather swipe through before clicking check it out
Understood feature
Clicks check it out, did not scroll through
Understood the feature
Clicks check it out first
Understood feature

Places to Go

Thought he could zoom/pan the map
Not sure if it includes activities too
Wanted it to show examples of what you can put
Thought you could pin something on the map
Would try to scroll around the map first
Wish there was a dollar sign here to show restaurant pricing
Wants to see more info when clicking into restaurant eg. reviews, photos
Didn't see the search box immediately
Felt like its asking him to drag and zoom the map

Setting up

5/5 Ease to set up

Some people don't care about food and drink
Missed the custom button
4/5 Ease to set up
She would like to add custom in "things to do"
Thought she can add activities in food + drink
5/5 - very easy

Chat Screen

Wondering when notification would come up
Feels annoying for notification to keep popping up
Is date preferences specific to each person?

Toggle/Stay tuned Screen

Date preferences and "interested on a date" feel like separate features
Toggle is not very useful for him
He would probably just ask directly
"I should be able to see their date preferences before deciding that I want to go on a date"
Expecting to see if they have similar interests, side by side comparison
What if they had different interests?
Would it just sit here? It would make her sad
Toggling is a little intimidating, not sure what would happen
She would toggle only because she would like to know date preferences
Not sure if toggling will notify her, makes him scared to toggle
Simplifies the process, makes it quicker and easier to know
He would use this feature with people he has not interacted much with
She thinks he will get notified when she toggles
Thinks it sends him a notification that she's ready for a date
She would use the toggle - skips the uncertainty

Date Preferences Screen

Understood that highlighted items are things he has in common
Understands meaning of highlighted tabs
Similar thing for food and drink, but for activities -> eg. Kayaking
Explore the outdoors is kinda vague
Don't want to know too much... takes away the mystery of wanting to chat
Don't need to know everything for first date
Want to use this as a way to start conversation
Not sure about cocktail icon for drinks
There's a lot of alcoholic drinks - What if people don't drink
Things to do should be similar to food and drink, where similarities are highlighted
Confused that the things to do is not following the same highlighted idea
Want more "things to do" icons being shown (more than 3)
Would want to see both his places and her places, longer list of potential places
Would be cool to see both peoples preferences
Surprise me option - makes it more exciting for her
She doesn't like to go to the same places again and again
Wants to try new suggestions, not just restaurants she likes
Based on activities, maybe it could show suggestions
maybe add an option to "like" something in his date pref
Is there a way to recommend a place in the chat?
Confusion over who's date preferences are shown
Is it her preferences or his preferences?
Understands that this is Ryan's preferences
Maybe a side by side comparison? Or only show ones that are matching

Date Map Screen

Would want address, integrated with google maps
Want to know more info about Meet on Main Eg. Google Maps
Helps her judge distance, how far she's willing to go
Wondering why theres no address
Cool to gauge the distance
would be cool to have more descriptions of each place if he clicks on it
Title is different. Places to go vs Ryan's places to go
Assume it would open up with more information -> google maps
Good to see the distance visually
Maybe add more information to each place eg. Type of cuisine

Would you use this feature

Adds value - Makes it easier to ask if they want to do something
4/5 likely to use this new feature, if there was no toggle
Adds value - different from the basic prompts, figure out a little bit more about the person
4/5 would use with toggle, 5/5 without toggle. It feels nerve racking
It would speed up the planning process for a first date
Already have a bunch of options
Would then ask her in the chat
His preferences are pretty easy/flexible
Helpful for someone who is asking/planning the date
5/5 would use
Yes this helps him ask her out, easier to set up date
go back to the chat and bring up sushi
Would be cool to see interests even if they're not interested in a date
Would be nice to use date pref as conversation topics
Feels like the toggle could be a separate feature
5/5 Would use
Yes, it helps a lot to know what he likes to pick a place
Would like a button where Hinge helps set up a date plan
She likes that it gives a nudge to somebody - non pushy way
4/5 would use, assuming she actually talks to someone long enough
She can pinpoint exactly what to eat
Cuts the planning time shorter - fasttracks everything
5/5 Would use
"Date Planning for dummies"

Untoggle Button

"I feel like once I toggle I would not feel the need to untoggle... I would not consider that"
She thinks the info is not personal, its general enough, no need to untoggle
Would maybe use a toggle off button, otherwise just unmatch
He doesn't care about showing or hiding his date preferences
If she's not interested in the date anymore, she would just unmatch
The toggle makes her think she can easily untoggle
Thinks there shouldn't be a untoggle - harmful if someone untoggles
Untoggle button would make people more anxious about dating
These things are pretty generic so its not sensitive info

Editing Date Preferences

First tried to click on preferences, then chat
4/5 Level of ease
it makes sense where it is, he just missed it at first
Tries chat first, then tries preferences
Because its called date preferences, she thought it was under preferences
4.5/5 Ease to find
Tried to go into preferences
Date preferences name is the same as preferences, confusing
3.5/4 ease to find
Tries to click preferences @ the top right of discover
Tries to click on preferences on profile
Using the existing app, he's already liked on a million things wrong by mistake
3.5/5 ease to find
Click into preferences in profile
Clicks into preferences on the discover page
Clicks into specific chat messages
2.5/5 - Did NOT find date preferences
clicks on the top right of discover for preferences
5/5 very easy

Score the Widgets

Things to do (3), Food + Drink (2), Places to go (1)

Thinks people won't put in places to go, too much effort

Neighbourhoods + When to Meet

He thinks it lets people know too much about him
His schedule changes too quickly throughout the week
Don't want to reveal too much about where he is
Feel a bit of hesitancy to share, dont want ppl to know where she frequents
Potential Stalking threat
When to meet is way more important than things to do
Neighbourhoods are helpful but not necessary
Not a huge fan, don't see a need
If he wants to see someone he would want to be flexible
If 2 people live too far, there's way too many neighbourhoods to account
When to meet is better than things to do - its a lot easier to schedule
"When to meet" takes away the conversation of having to figure out the schedule
Very helpful, saves her hours of time of scheduling
No security concerns, it won't say anything about where she is
